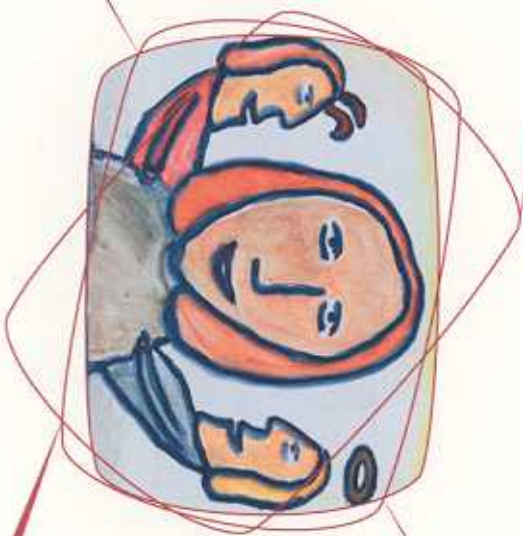

Misusing computer resources -including sending threatening or harassing emails or violating copyright law- has been found to be a violation of Stanford's Fundamental Standard?
