

## **Artificial Intelligence and Academic Integrity – Facilitated by Myke Healy**

- One participant talked about seeing unusual phrasings and more of those AI-tell words like 'delve'
- It was observed that editing suggestions or preamble notes from AI tools are occasionally left in final submissions
- It was noted how students ask for help "making papers sound more like me" after using AI to generate drafts
- "Explain your work" sessions have revealed students who cannot articulate the reasoning behind their own submissions
- One participant remarked on students generating multiple AI drafts or using 'humanizers' to avoid detection
- Declining attendance in instructor office hours has coincided with increased AI reliance
